Dear Parent or Guardian

State law requires that all children have an annual dental screening before entering school each year. To help with this, the dental staff from the Community Health Center of Southeast Kansas will be providing **FREE** dental screenings for all students enrolled at your child's school. After the screenings, you will receive information on the results and any recommendations for follow-up with your family dentist.

During these screenings, many schools have also approved CHC/SEK dentists and hygienists to provide care that prevents tooth decay. These services include protecting the teeth with the application of a fluoride varnish or dental sealant. If your school is participating in this program, there will be a special consent attached to this form. If not, and you are interested in having these services for your child, please contact your family dentist or call CHC/SEK at 1-866-396-6788 and an appointment will be made at the nearest CHC/SEK dental clinic.

**Please note that there is no out-of-pocket cost to the school or the family for these services.**
